

SITES THAT EDUCATE

Forestville Road Elementary

Forestville Road Elementary School, located adjacent to a tributary of Beaverdam Creek, was designed to reduce negative environmental impacts on the creek, which flows to the protected Neuse River. The Neuse River empties into the Albemarle-Pamlico Estuary, the second largest and one of the most productive estuaries in the United States.

The students of Forestville Road Elementary participated in a hands-on environmental education program where they learned about the importance of water quality and how the design of their school helps to clean storm water. The program included an outdoor field day where students planted the bioretention and constructed wetlands areas on the school property.

Outreach efforts extended the educational aspect of the wetland planting to the students' families through a bilingual pamphlet sent home to parents of this multi-cultural school.
